MEETING MINUTES

The meeting was called to order by President Cathy Sayre at 7:06 PM.

Secretary's Report:

- Minutes from the November meeting were presented. Melissa Arnold made a motion to accept the minutes. Jodi Conley seconded.

Treasurer's Report:

- Income and expenses for November 19 through January 28 were presented.
- Account Balances: \$21,827 in Checking (\$6,432.33 of this is in student accounts) and \$21,723.91 in Savings.
- Jodi Conley made a motion to accept the treasurer's report. Cindy Smith seconded.

Old Business

- Fundraising:
 - Honda Raffle: We have sold fewer than 500 tickets for the Honda Fit. Discussed options for selling enough tickets to raffle the car.
 - iGive: This is an easy way to earn money for the band. Just sign up at igive.com and then do searches from there. Also – if you enter online shopping sites by clicking through igive.com the band will earn between 1% and 8% of the sales.
 - MarketDay: Tami Cox reported that sales are up \$200-\$300 per month. Middle school sales have been disappointing.
 - Sub Sale: 23 students participated in this year's sale.
- Chicago Trip: The last payment to New Horizons is due February 5 and tonight is the deadline to transfer funds from your student's account.
- Paint for practice field: We were charged \$8 per gallon for 90 gallons of paint by the athletic department for painting the practice field (\$720). There is no record of exactly when the painting was done, but attendees could recall several times between band camp and the end of football season.
- Winter Guard: The winter guard's first show is February 6. They will compete four times between Feb 6 and Mar 20. Band boosters are managing winter guard fees and payment of bills, but are not directly sponsoring this activity.
- Nationwide Fundraiser: Dale Proshok reported that a total of 22 people have been trained, and 7-10 people are actively working at Nationwide Arena. We have earned

\$1400 in 5 events. \$600 of this went into student accounts, the remainder went into the general fund. Please sign up for the available February dates.

New Business:

- The Night of Jazz: The Night of Jazz will be held on May 3. Christen Meyers will chair the committee to plan and put on the event. Please see Christen to join the planning committee.
- Band Awards Banquet: We need volunteers to help plan and execute this event. It will be held in the Monarch Commons and the Auditorium this year. Date TBD.
- Tag Day: The pros and cons of holding a tag day (door-to-door solicitation) were discussed. We need to check on city ordinances. Tying a tag day to a specific activity was also discussed. No conclusions were reached.

Directors' Report:

- Mr. Thissen reminded everyone that the Winter band concert is scheduled for March 1.
- There is an optional solo contest on Saturday, February 13. Interested students have already signed up.
- 8th grade recruiting night was a success. 70 people attended.
- Chicago Trip Meeting is scheduled for Tuesday 2/16 at 7 PM. The tour coordinator will be there. This meeting is mandatory for parents. Bill has a list of balances for trip fees.

Discussion:

- Jodi and Shirley showed us the parade banner they repaired. It looked wonderful – thank you Jodi and Shirley!
