## MEETING MINUTES

The meeting was called to order by President Cathy Sayre at 7:00 PM.

### Secretary's Report:

- Minutes from the October meeting were presented. Tami Cox made a motion to accept the minutes. Dale Proshok seconded.

### Treasurer's Report:

- Income and expenses for October were presented. Brian asked about an expenditure of \$720 charged to us by the athletic department for practice field painting. Cathy will call Cal Adams.
- Doug Brake made a motion to accept the treasurer's report. Brad Conley seconded.

### Old Business

- Fundraising:
  - Greenery sale: 33 Students participated in the sale and a total of \$975.74 was deposited to student accounts. (Average = \$29.57 per student)
  - Market Day: Tami Cox reported that she took flyers to the middle school for band students. She will continue to include the middle school band in Market Day advertising.
  - Honda Raffle: Raffle tickets make great stocking stuffers! Will email parents with "stocking stuffer" idea.
  - Bob Chapman Ford tire sale: Bob Chapman donated \$1 for each tire sold during their tire sale and gave us the proceeds from the grill tent. The band received \$116 from tire sales and \$63.06 from donations at the grill tent. Total = \$179.06.
  - Other: Scott's MiracleGro sent a \$100 donation.

- Nationwide Fundraiser: Dale Proshok reported that a total of 22 people have been trained, but our group has not yet worked this season. Dale will call a meeting of Nationwide volunteers to go over procedures and coordinate available dates. Please let Dale know when you are available to work if you have not yet done so.

New Business:

- Jamie is holding meetings with students interested in participating in Winter guard. Competitions are held indoors and the Winter Guard season begins after football season ends.

Directors' Report:

- Mr. Fannin reported that all the directors are proud of the kids' performance at State Finals. The band got 1's in all categories and it was their best performance of the year. Students are auditioning this week for concert band placement.
- Pep Band: All students must play at at least 3 of 4 basketball games. The four dates are December 4 and 11, January 22, February 5.
- Big Jazz: There are more than 60 students that want to be in Jazz Band this year. Big Jazz (all jazz band students) will perform at basketball games on January 8 and 29, February 2 and 12. Have not determined if Jazz band will be required to play at 3 or 4 of the games. Big Jazz rehearsals will be on Mondays after school until the end of January.
- Jazz Band: There are two jazz bands – Red and Blue. Red Jazz is the beginner band where technique is developed. Blue Jazz is a smaller group of more advanced students. The Jazz band is looking for performance opportunities – maybe at a dance or community event.
- Macy's Thanksgiving Day Parade: Six of our students will be traveling to New York to participate in the Macy's All American band. Congratulations!
- Chicago Parade: Students will be required to have music for the parade memorized by late February.
