

MHSBBI Booster Meeting July 17, 2008

President Art Woolum called the meeting to order.

Secretary Report: Minutes from May 22, 2008 meeting were read, motion to approve by Brian Dillahunt, second Yvette Edwards. Motion passed. Minutes from booster meetings will be sent out via email after each meeting and are available on the booster website www.MHSBBI.org.

Treasurer Report: 2007-2008 Summary – Art went through previous year budget, between actual and budget amounts. Motion to approve 2007-2008 as written by Dick Bergandine, second by Yvette Edwards. Motion passed.

The 2008-2009 budget was submitted by the board. Art explained line for line, income and expenses. After discussion it was discovered that some expenses were omitted. Motion by Brian Dillahunt to table 2008-09 budget until next booster meeting, second by Trina Beaching. Finalization of 2008-2009 budget will be at August booster meeting.

Kroger cards are available for \$5. Student receives 5% of amount loaded on Kroger card. Nationwide and Market Day will also be fund raisers this year. Honda Hero's is a fund raiser that has really gone unused. Any Honda associate can earn \$250 per year for 50 hours of volunteer work. Melissa will obtain additional information regarding this and share at next booster meeting.

Old Business:

Honda Fundraiser: Brian Dillahunt gave following information regarding this fundraiser.

1. Tickets have been printed and are available for sale. \$100 per ticket.
2. Tickets may be signed out to sell 5 at a time.
3. All tickets sold by August 1, 2008, will have their name printed in football program as a band patron.
4. \$10 of each ticket a band member sells will be put in student's account. Student will need to put their name on back of stub that is turned in.
5. Volunteers are needed for home football games to help sell tickets at booth.
6. Brian needs a couple volunteers to go to Honda Marysville and get certified to drive the Accord that is being raffled off. You will need your driver's license, insurance card, and sign a waiver at Honda Marysville to do this.

Uniform fittings – There are still 5 students that need fittings. Shirley Drumm is going to assist with alterations. This expense has been included in the budget.

School instruments – Any student using a school instrument will be required to pay a \$50 non-refundable deposit. This deposit will be used to cover maintenance and cleaning of the instrument.

New Business:

Band Camp –

Art has 2 medical associates lined up to assist with band camp. We still need volunteers for water/ice detail. Band camp is from 9-5, beginning on August 4th. Water donations are needed. Each student is being asked to donate 1 case of water. Band boosters are NOT supplying food or snacks this year. The last few years the monies for food and snacks were part of the Band Fees. Due to the increase in Pay to Play and the unknown transportation fee amount, it was decided not to bill for food this year. Students will need to pack their lunches, snacks, and beverages. They will not be allowed to leave

for lunch. Band fees are due by July 24, 2008. All fees must be paid by July 24, 2008 to participate in band camp. Tennis shoes are also a requirement, students will be marching a lot! Sun screen, hat or visor, and light colored clothing are also suggested.

Student Fund Raising:

Because of additional costs, such as \$150 pay to play, and transportation fees (still undetermined) the students are being given the opportunity to raise money to pay these fees. Cathy Sayre presented the following list of fund raisers that will be available for the students:

Cooke dough sale – will start August 4th and end on August 25th. Students will earn 43% of each container sold.

Spring flower bulbs – will start September 8th and end on September 25th.

Greenery sale – will start October 6th and end October 20th. Greenery comes in week of Thanksgiving.

Sub sale – will start January 5th and end on January 19th. Subs will be in right before the Super Bowl. Students will earn \$1.01 on each sub sold.

Pizza sale – will be in middle of February, 2009.

Cheesecake sale – will be held early part of April, 2009.

Chaperones:

We are in need of chaperones for August 1st Ohio State Fair. You will need to ride the buses with the band students, and you get into the fair for free!! Chaperones are also needed for future band functions. Please contact MHSBBI if you are interested in helping out.

Fair Parade:

Parade is July 21, 2008. Students need to pick up t-shirts at MHS band room at 3:30pm on Monday, July 21st. Line up is at 4:30pm, and parade begins at 5:00pm. Parade will end at the Middle School.
