Treasure Report:

Old Business:

No student fundraising planned at this time but working on lining things up for summer/fall for student accounts;

Honda Raffle –

(The following information provided by chair Brian Dillahunt)

2008-2009 MHSBBI – Honda Marysville Raffle

Goal: Sell 500 tickets at \$100.00 each for income of \$50,000.

Honda Marysville to sell us 2008 V/6 Accord with Navigation.

MSRP price: \$30,895.00

Price to MHSBBI: \$27,391.00

MHSBBI cost: \$25,000.00

Honda Marysville balance paid: \$2,391.00

Honda Marysville will pay for: signage for auto, banner for football game display;

Tickets will be paid by MHSBBI;

MHSBBI responsible for selling tickets and displaying the car.

Target is to sell all tickets-revenue of \$50,000 and MHSBBI write check back to Honda for \$25,000 to purchase vehicle and keep the balance for the Boosters. If all tickets not sold a split pot will take place.

Russ Jones coordinates MHS football program and per conversation with him - the advertising rate is \$225/page, with a willingness to cut a better deal since we are part of the school. I will follow up in June, and in August print date will be the cut-off.

Recommend that 10% of each ticket sold go to that student's band account (\$10 of every \$100).

Use MHSBBI homepage and email lists to coordinate ticket sales over the summer.

New Business:

Linda Schwynn spoke for "Citizens for School Group", discussing the need to get a lot of current and *correct* information out to the community on levy/school funding issues. Director's Report:

Band Banquet was a huge success;

Deral Carson donated profits from DVD to the booster's! (Thank you so much Deral and for putting together such a wonderful keepsake memory for our kids!);

HER donated \$600 to cover transport cost for the Memorial Day Parade! (Thank you HER!);

Wind Ensemble and Symphonic Band playing at graduation;

Jamie Clark has been hired as the new flag instructor for the 2008 marching season!

Looking forward, we will be marching approximately 160 to 170 this fall. There are still some uncertainties as the exact cost – mostly due to waiting on decision for transportation costs/fees. Deposit/Intent form is due May 27th. Proposed fee's are: **(PLEASE NOTE THESE RATES ARE NOT SET IN STONE YET!)**

Freshmen: \$305.50

Soph/Jr.: \$263.50

Seniors: \$273.50 (\$10 for senior braid)

This cost *includes* the \$150 pay to play fee tagged by the school and covers band camp, uniform rental, dry cleaning, (a break out of cost will be included in your student's statement). Keep in mind that students will be packing lunches for camp and a big part of the cost cut is including meals with camp. Brian Dillahunt made a motion that boosters will subsidize a portion (YET TO BE DETERMINED) to help off set costs of fees – Evetta Edwards 2nd and motion was passed.
