

**Marysville High School Band Boosters**  
**August 27, 2009**

The August 2009 meeting was called to order by Vice President Brian Dillahunt at 7:00 PM in the band room of the Marysville High School. This was also our Freshman Band Night. Brian introduced all the board members.

The minutes of the previous meeting were available online and in hard copy for all to review. There were no additions or corrections to those minutes. Melissa moved to approve and Mr. Break seconded. Minutes approved.

Treasurer's Report: All fundraiser totals of income were announced as to date. Motion was made and all accepted report.

Old Business:

- Band Camp went very well. Thanks to all those that volunteered. We had no injuries and the food was a big hit.
- Pop and Water: Although we have had pop and water donations come in, we are still in need of more. We supply this not only for our own band but for our visiting band members as well. Due to the contract the school has with Pepsi, Pepsi products are asked to be brought in instead of COKE. (Pepsi products are on sale 24 pack for \$5.97 at Walmart this week).
- Fundraisers:
  - Nationwide Arena – Dale Proshak reviewed how it works. Parents work mainly Hockey games but did have a chance to take in some concerts etc. last year. Everyone does 3-3 ½ of training. We make \$40 per person plus extra after a certain point. Twenty dollars of this will be credited to the student account and the other \$20 goes to the band boosters.
  - Market Day: Brian reviewed Market Day. You can order with the forms we provide or you can go online to place your order and pick up your food at the band room. The boosters make 10% profit. If you have question call Tammy Cox 644-1087.
  - Spirit Cards sell for \$10. These can be checked out for sale.
  - Honda Raffle: Buy one for yourself. Maybe sell 10 more. Winner will be able to pick from a Honda Civic or a Honda Fit. We will have the car in the Parade. Need to really push the sale of these tickets so we can give the car away this year. Tickets are \$10 (not \$100 like last year).

Directors Report: The band is doing well. Kids are being asked to read the white board for all notes each day. Everything they need to know will be posted there. The next 2 games kids will wear their summer uniform. Our 3<sup>rd</sup> game we hope to have our uniforms ready to wear. Students are asked to be in the band room at 4:30PM. Pizza will be supplied for students for dinner. After students eat they will exit to the field to review the show. Students are expected to be done and ready to go home between 10 and 10:30PM. The first after school practice was today. Practices will be on Tuesday and Thursdays from 3-5:00PM. Directors ask if possible to schedule kid's appointments on other days. On Saturday, September 19<sup>th</sup> we will be going to an evening band contest. Possibly will be 8:00 or after before the MHS performs. Second contest will be The Ohio Buckeye Invitational on October 3<sup>rd</sup>. Students should perform between 2:00 and 5:00PM. The long awaited arrival of the Marimba will be here on Monday. We will not be going to the pumpkin festival this year. At this point we do have enough Chaperones for the trip.

Uniform report: They are almost done. The kids will use t-shoes for Friday night game.

Crew: We have our new trailer. Parents are asked to not park along the building so the trailers can be parked, loaded and moved. Please drop off and pick up in different location. We are in need of parent volunteers to load and unload. Benefits are you get in free. We will have use of a camper to take for pit crew and potluck.

New Business:

Festafair: We are need of volunteers for a 2 hour shift. 9<sup>th</sup> graders are asked to bring cookies, 10<sup>th</sup> grade cupcakes, 11<sup>th</sup> grade Brownies, and 12<sup>th</sup> grade pies. These need to be brought to the band room by the 11<sup>th</sup>. Please park them with a list of ingredients.

Season Tickets for the football game. Please be sure when purchasing season tickets to let them know you are with the band. We will get half the price of the ticket.

Directors Extra Note: Please know it is very important to help the band boosters with all fundraisers. The band has not received any money for 5 years from the district. We most likely will not get any money for a few more years. So what the band boosters do is very important.
